## JB's Recipe choices....

## **Spiked Orange Smoothie**

8 ounces frozen orange juice concentrate

- 1 ounce sugar-free, fat free vanilla pudding mix
- 1 (4 ounce) orange cream yogurt (recommend Yoplait)
- 1 cup lowfat milk
- 1 cup vanilla flavored vodka
- 1/4 cup orange flavored liqueur
- 2 cups ice cubes

Combine all ingredients in a blender. Blend until smooth and pour into glasses



#### **Key West Fruit Salad**

34 cup sugar

1/4 cup water

1/4 cup fresh or bottled key lime juice or regular lime juice

- 2-3 tablespoons tequila or key lime juice
- 1 teaspoon grated key lime or regular lime peel
- 14 cups cut up fresh fruit (pineapple, strawberries, kiwi, grapes)
  - 1. In 1 ½ quart saucepan, heat sugar and water to boiling; reduce heat. Simmer uncovered about 2 minutes, stirring constantly until sugar is dissolved; remove from heat and stir in lime juice and tequila.
  - 2. Let lime dressing stand until room temperature. Cover and refrigerate about 2 hours or until cool.
  - 3. Stir lime peel into dressing. In a very large bowl, carefully toss fruit and dressing. Serve immediately.
